INTRODUCTION:

Archive360's Modern Slavery Statement has been published in accordance with the provisions of the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Archive360 is committed to undertaking business with integrity and honesty, which is reflected in every aspect of our business, including consideration for human rights. Archive360 requires all officers, employees and business partners to comply with all laws, rules and regulations governing human rights in the territories in which Archive360 operates. STATEMENT:
